

# Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

## Invitation to tender for proposals for Hillbrow, Berea and Yeoville Public Art Consultants

The Johannesburg Development Agency (JDA) invites tenders from service providers specialising in public art to procure public art for the neighbourhoods of Hillbrow, Berea and Yeoville in the 07/08 financial year as part of the JDA's public environment upgrade of these areas.

The acquisition of public art is a component of a larger strategic intervention, which is being undertaken in an attempt to reverse the current trends of degeneration in Hillbrow, Berea and Yeoville and to promote these areas as sustainable inner city neighbourhoods.

**The service provider will in consultation with the JDA manage, at least, the following processes:**

- Project definition (including the development of an overall conceptual framework to govern the selection of the public art pieces)
- Sourcing artwork
- Commissioning artwork (including the request for concept design proposals from artists)
- Purchase of existing works
- Assembling and management of a Public Art Advisory Group to select artworks where necessary
- Management of the selection of artworks (including all administration consistent with this)
- Management of the installation of artworks.

A non-refundable tender fee of R1000.00 deposited in the JDA bank account, ABSA, Account No. 4054394825, Branch Code: 301305 is required on collection of the tender documents.

The proposals must be placed in a sealed envelope. The words **"Tender for Hillbrow, Berea and Yeoville Public Art - Contract No JDA 035E Public Artworks"** must be clearly written or typed on the envelope. The envelope must be deposited in the tender box at **the Johannesburg Development Agency, Ground Floor, 3 President Street, The Bus Factory, Johannesburg.**

There will be a compulsory briefing session on 24 October 2007 at 09:00 for service providers who have purchased the tender documents.

The documents may be collected during working hours after 12:00 from 10 October 2007.

**The tender closes at 12:00 on 29 October 2007.**

No late/telephonic/faxed/postal/e-mail tenders will be accepted or considered.

The Johannesburg Development Agency's selection of qualifying tenders will be in the Johannesburg Development Agency's sole discretion and will be final. The Johannesburg Development Agency does not bind itself to accept any particular tender. Correspondence will be entered into with the successful tender.
