

# Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

**Construction of Section 1 BRT Trunk Route from the intersection of Klipspruit Valley Road/Sofasonke Street (km 5.1) to Modderspruit Culvert (intersection of Main/Modder Roads) (km 8.7).**

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the conversion of the existing Mooki Street and a small section of Sofasonke Street to accommodate BRT-type vehicles, including the construction of five BRT station platforms.

Furthermore, approximately eight signalised intersections will be converted to signalised roundabouts.

The tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 8 or higher. Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction works.

Preferences are offered to tenderers who have Black Equity Ownership, Black Executive Management and General Workforce participation.

Documents may be collected during working hours after 12:00pm from Monday, 14 July 2008.

Payment can be made by either an electronic funds transfer or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Johannesburg Development Agency. Proof of payment is required on collection of the tender documents.
