The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the Westbury Precinct: NMT Implementation Phase 2.

This involves the construction of Sophiatown Non-motorised Transport (NMT) Routes Extension Infrastructure along Thornton Road, Lewes Road, 4th Avenue and Dublin Road, in Sophiatown. The scope of works entails traffic accommodation, clearing and grabbing, earthworks, layer works and asphalt overlay, construction of sidewalks and cycle lanes, soft and hard landscaping, remedial works on existing civil services and installation of new ones, road marking and signage and street lighting upgrade.

It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 6CE or higher.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the Tender Data.

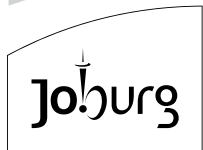
