Consultant Services: Community Participation Consultants for the Rea Vaya Phase 1C Sandton Loop

Request for formal written priced proposals for consultant services.

The proposed site is in Sandton north of Johannesburg. The Rea Vaya Phase 1C Sandton Loop is part of the Rea Vaya Sections 15, 8 and 9 trunk routes operations along Louis Botha, Katherine Drive and Sandton Drive and Republic Road. These trunk routes connect the Johannesburg CBD to Alexandra, Sandton and Randburg CBD. The Loop will traverse along Rivonia Road, Fredman Drive and 5th Street. Included in the scope of works will be the design of complementary routes' infrastructure along Rivonia Road between Sandton and Sunninghill and along 11th Street between Sandton and Parkmore. The community participation consultant (CPC) is required to demonstrate in the submission the relevant skills, experience and capacity to deliver the scope of work within the required timeframe. The contract period will be for 24 months and the services should cater for public engagement during design, construction and project completion/close out.
