Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction works.

The JDA is requesting proposals from experienced companies and joint ventures to render mechanical engineering services (including a wet services consultant) required to design and manage the implementation of upgrade initiatives for Phases 5 and 6 of the Inner City Commuter Links Public Environment Upgrade project in the 2014/15 and 2015/16 financial years, ie July 2014 to June 2016. There will be a design and implementation phase in each year.

The precinct which will be upgraded through this project is termed the Art Gallery Rea Vaya Station Precinct and is focused around Joubert Park in the inner city of Johannesburg. The precinct is roughly bounded by Smit Street in the North, Twist Street in the East, Plein Street in the South, and Wanderers Street in the West.
