Rea Vaya Bus Rapid Transport (BRT) System: Phase 1C, Alex BRT Terminal Earthworks, Lateral Support & Piling - Work Package 15G1

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the construction and upgrading of BRT Section 15 – Work Package 15G1 along Louis Botha and Old Pretoria Main to Chadwick/Old Pretoria Road intersection. The scope of works entails traffic accommodation, lateral support, bulk earthworks, piling, construction of BRT bus lanes and service relocations (if required).

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the Rea Vaya BRT Section 15 (Phase 1) – Work Package 15G1.

It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 9CE or higher.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.
