The JDA is requesting proposals from Civil Engineers and Urban Designers/Architects for the design and the implementation of the Westbury Non-motorised Transport Phase 3: Westdene Dam project in the 2015/16 and 2016/17, financial years ie July 2015 to June 2017. The design phase is to be completed in 2015/16. The scope of works will comprise of pedestrian walkways, cycle lanes, street lightning upgrade, soft and hard landscaping. The proposal must include all services required to deliver the above stated scope of works. A copy of the proposed route will be made available to the successful tenderer.
