The JDA is requesting proposals for a Civil Engineer and Community Participation Consultant for the design and implementation of the Empire Perth Corridor of Freedom Stormwater Master Plan and the Turffontein Corridor Stormwater Master Plan respectively. The design phase for both is to be completed in the first quarter of 2016/17. The scope of works will comprise review of the JRA-approved Stormwater Master Plan, and detailed design and implementation of the stormwater upgrades. The proposal must include all engineering services required to deliver the above stated scope of works. A copy of the approved Master Plan will be made available to the successful tenderer. The projects will be implemented over three financial years.
