For Inner City Core Precinct Public Environment Upgrade Phase 2

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the Inner City Core Precinct Public Environment Upgrade.

It is envisaged that the bulk of the work will be executed by at least seven (7) emerging local contractors with a CIDB grading ranging from 2CE to 3CE. The Project will also entail the inclusion of City of Johannesburg, JOZI@WORK programme.

It is estimated that each tenderer should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or higher and CIDB-registered contractors will be eligible to tender.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.
