The JDA is requesting proposals for a Consortium of Engineers and Community Participation Consultant to design and implement Inner City Managed Lanes.

The design and implementation is to be completed in the 2016/17 financial year. The JDA has been appointed as an implementation agency on behalf of COJ Transportation for the implementation of managed lanes. The scope of works entails public environment upgrades, roadworks and street furniture on identified managed lanes.
