The scope of works entails the construction of the BRT link between Alex Mall along Peace Street, Longmeadow Street connecting into Greenstone Mall for a BRT park and ride facility. The scope of works include construction of lay-bys, road markings, bus shelters and road signage along the proposed BRT bus routes as well as a park and ride facility at Greenstone Mall.
