A suitably qualified consortium of professionals are hereby invited to tender for the civil, structural, electrical engineering, quantity surveying and architectural or urban design services for the 2010 Training Venues: Assessment of Venues and FIFA Requirements.

**BACKGROUND**

The Johannesburg Development Agency (JDA) has been tasked with the responsibility of assessing the infrastructure status of the training venues and their surrounding precincts for the 2010 World Cup. A strategy to upgrade said venues and precincts in order to fulfil the requirements set by FIFA must then be developed. In addition, attention must be paid to legacy after 2010.

**Group B:** Orlando, Rand and Ruimsig

**PROPOSAL CALL**

Consortium for the Civil, Structural and Electrical Engineering, Quantity Surveying and Architect/ Urban Design services.

The JDA requires the services of the abovementioned disciplines to work together in assisting the JDA in achieving the tasks mentioned above for either Group A or Group B. The works are expected to commence on 31 May 2006 and completion is expected by 31 July 2006.

Due to the stringent timeframes on this project, significant emphasis will be placed on the tenderers' ability to deliver the project on time, within budget and to the required quality.

**TENDER DOCUMENTS**

Documents can be obtained from the offices of the Johannesburg Development Agency, 90 Market Street, Johannesburg, from 09:00 on Wednesday, 17 May 2006 on payment of a non-refundable deposit of R200.00. Payment can be made by either a direct deposit into the JDA bank account (proof of payment to be supplied on collection of tender documentation) or by bank guaranteed cheque, which must be crossed and made payable to the Johannesburg Development Agency.

The completed tender document should be placed in a sealed envelope. The words: "Tender for Contract No JDA 032.3/CN001 (Group A) or JDA 032.3/CN002 (Group B) Civil, Structural and Electrical Engineering Services in consortium with a Quantity Surveyor and an Architect or Urban Designer" must be clearly written/typed on the envelope. The envelope must be deposited in the tender box at the Johannesburg Development Agency, Ground Floor, 90 Market Street, Johannesburg, only between the hours of 07:00 and 10:00. The tender closes at 10:00 on Friday, 26 May 2006.

Envelopes will be stamped on receipt. There will be no public opening of tenders.

**No late/telephonic/faxed/postal tenders will be accepted or considered.**

The Johannesburg Development Agency's selection of qualifying tenders will be in the Johannesburg Development Agency's sole discretion and will be final. The Johannesburg Development Agency does not bind itself to accept any particular tender and no correspondence will be entered into.
