The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the Rotunda Park Precinct Project in Turffontein – Phase 3: Construction of Linear Park.

Tenderers are to note that some of the work must be executed by emerging local contractors.

It is estimated that each tenderer should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 7SH and above. The combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a 7SH or higher class of construction work determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.
