Rehabilitation of Existing Road - Nasrec BRT Phase1 Pat Mbatha Motorway, Booyens

The Johannesburg Development Agency (JDA) invites tenders for the rehabilitation of BRT lanes and associated road works on Pat Mbatha Motorway Nasrec BRT Phase 1, Booyens.

Qualifying tenderers should be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction works and have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 8CE or higher at the time of tender. Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders, provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.

A non-refundable tender fee of R1000.00 must be deposited in the JDA's bank account as follows: ABSA Account No: 4054394825, Branch Code: 301305. Proof of payment is required upon collection of the tender documents. Tenderers must put their company name as reference, when making the bank deposit for the tender payment.

The proposals must be placed in a sealed envelope. The words "Nasrec BRT Phase 1 Rehabilitation Tender" must be clearly written or typed on the envelope, including the above reference number. The envelope must be deposited in the tender box at the Johannesburg Development Agency, Ground Floor, The Bus Factory, 3 President Street, Johannesburg.

The documents may be collected during working hours from 12:00 beginning Wednesday, 10 November 2010.

A compulsory site clarification meeting with representatives of the professional team and the Employer will take place at 09:30 on Thursday, 18 November 2010. Tenderers are to meet at Caltex Garage on Pat Mbatha Motorway in Booyens - Westbound.

The tender closes at 12:00 on Monday, 8 December 2010.

No late/telephonic/faxed/postal/e-mail tenders will be accepted or considered.

The Johannesburg Development Agency's selection of qualifying tenders will be in the Johannesburg Development Agency's sole discretion and will be final.
