The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders from construction companies for the Stormwater Masterplan Implementation: Empire Perth Corridor Phase 1A Construction in Johannesburg. It is estimated that the tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 8CE or higher and 7CE PE registered contractors will be eligible to the tender.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.

The successful tenderer will be expected to manage a component of the emerging sub-contractors who will be responsible for executing portions of the work. The Project will also entail the inclusion of City of Johannesburg, JOZI@WORK programme.
