

Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

Traffic Engineering Professionals for a Traffic Impact Assessment (TIA) around the Rea Vaya Phase 1C Trunk Route.

The JDA invites proposals for Traffic Impact Assessment (TIA) around the Rea Vaya BRT Phase 1C for Traffic Engineering Services.

Proposals are invited for a Traffic Impact Assessment (TIA) on key roads/streets around and adjacent to the Rea Vaya Phase 1C trunk route, Section 15. The City of Johannesburg (CoJ) is proposing to introduce the Rea Vaya BRT system along Louis Botha Avenue, between the Johannesburg CBD and the corner of Pretoria Main and Lees Street. This route is referred to as Section 15.

After a detailed traffic impact assessment along this route, it has become clear to the CoJ that some major roads/streets along and crossing the Louis Botha corridor, especially the ones that provide the east to west connections across Louis Botha, will be somewhat affected. The CoJ has decided to conduct an assessment in order to gather a better understanding of the traffic impact on key roads/streets around the Section 15 trunk route. The work comprises a full Traffic Impact Assessment on identified key roads/streets, signal designs, redesign of existing traffic signals and design of traffic calming measures. The proposal must include all the engineering required to deliver a full TIA, new signal designs, review of existing signal designs, and design of traffic calming measures.

Documents may be collected during working hours after 12:00 from Monday, 11 November 2013.

Tenders must only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued. The retyping of the tender document is not permitted.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the tender data.

The JDA's selection of qualifying tenders will be at the JDA's sole discretion and will be final. The JDA does not bind itself to accept any particular tender. Correspondence will be entered into with the successful tenderer.
