The JDA is requesting proposals from Project Managers, Quantity Surveyors, Civil Engineers and Electrical Engineers whom together, will form the professional team that provides the consulting services required to plan, design and manage the implementation of public environment upgrade initiatives and installation of bulk infrastructure in the Nancefield Station Precinct over three financial years. The services of a community participation consultant and an occupational health and safety agent are also called for.

The Nancefield Station Precinct is situated within the Klipspruit Township, east of the Klipspruit Valley. It is approximately 18km to the south of Johannesburg Inner City and 8km west of the N1 Highway the Diepkloof Interchange. The precinct is boarded by Moroko (Nancefield) Road on the south, Sofasonke Street on the north, Mbambisa Drive on the east and floodplain area on the west. Maponya Mall is located approximately 3km south of the precinct.
