Contract No: Exhibition Curator Chancellor House/CN007: Chancellor House Exhibition

The JDA is requesting proposals from exhibition curators to design and manage the implementation of an exhibition at the Chancellor House Building as part of the Chancellor House Renovation project.

Experienced companies and/or joint ventures, with a suitably qualified and experienced team and with a proven track record of delivery are hereby invited to serve on the professional team to develop a heritage exhibition as part of the renovation of Chancellor House (on the basis of an existing building conceptual proposal).

The "Chancellor House" building is a historic building that used to be the law offices of Nelson Mandela and Oliver Tambo and has over the years deteriorated physically and economically into a "bad building". The renovation of this building will assist in a revival of the precinct, which will bring back business, environmental cleanliness, residents, consumers and add an element of heritage preservation and tourist attraction. Part of this renovation is the inclusion of a permanent exhibition.

Due to the need to preserve the history and heritage the exhibition design should focus on place and building use identity and the creation of a world-class quality exhibition of a historically significant building based on the following: •The history of the building •The significant history of people connected to the building •The significant history of events linked to the building and its history •Legibility of specific historical links, timelines and themes •Enhancing the tourism attraction to the building •Preserving and promoting heritage and history.

The implementation of this project will take place in the current JDA financial year of 2009/2010 June and into the next financial year of 2010/2011 July to June.

Chancellor House is situated on the corner of Ntemi Piliso Street and Fox Street, Ferreirasdorp, Johannesburg.

Preference will be given to tenderers who have Black Equity Ownership, Black Executive Management and General Workforce participation.
