Request for Proposals for: PROFESSIONAL TEAM – DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION –TRAFFIC, CIVIL AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING

Tenderers are invited to submit proposals for the 'design and implementation' of the BRT Busways between Alexandra to Sandton (Section 8) and Alexandra to Parktown (section 15). The work comprises providing the requisite Traffic, Civil and Structural engineering design and the implementation of Sections 8 and 15 of the BRT network. The proposal must include for all the engineering required to deliver the infrastructure that will support a fully functional and effective BRT system.

The JDA invites proposals for **BRT Sections 8 and 15 – Design and Implementation**

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the Tender Data.
